

## TOP TEN WAYS OF DONATING TO CYE SAILING CENTRE

# 1

### **Monthly or quarterly standing order from your bank:**

We are seeking to raise approximately £40,000 per year in new regular giving.

This seems a frightening amount but we must not feel daunted. We have so many supporters, most of whom have visited the Centre, had great times and been helped personally. If a large number can give small (and some not so small) amounts we can readily achieve this.

For example if:

- 50 people give £5 every three months
- 100 people give £5 every month
- 100 people give £10 every month
- 50 people give £20 every month
- 10 people give £40 every month
- 10 people give £50 every month

This would cover the need and allow some reserve for unexpected costs. Having a larger number of regular donors will also put us in a more favourable position with Trusts who are considering our grant applications.

### **Lump Sum Donation:**

For example, following the sale of an asset (car, house, Caravan maybe) or on receipt of windfall, insurance maturity or annual bonus, or bequest to you. These gifts are very important as they often enable a larger project to either get started or be completed. The lump sum could be any amount from £50 to £500,000!

If you are an internet shopper, simply by using our shopping site [www.cye.spendandgive.co.uk](http://www.cye.spendandgive.co.uk) as a gateway to over 150 approved retailers, including car and house insurance providers, you can raise funds to support the CYE Bursary fund without spending any more than you would have by going to the retailers directly. Your spending generates commission to CYE bursary fund.

## **Gifts in Kind:**

For example, volunteering labour or time for a job, regularly or occasionally, or giving some equipment or materials that can either be used or sold and the funds put into the work. A donated boat was recently sold and funds used for the work under this scheme. Each Monday a group called the "KOGS", come to the centre and do essential repairs, maintenance and grounds work. Recently one of them completed the testing of 170 portable appliances that would have cost a great deal had we employed a commercial electrical contractor!

## **Gifts through Northwood Missionary Auctions:**

This Christian Charity sells items of furniture, glass, china and many other items at professional auctions each April and October. If designated these are sold free of commission with the full funds coming to CYESC. The auction in October 2005 raised £537 for CYESC. ## **Support from your business:**

Perhaps a donation or sponsorship to an area of work or expense such as training, computers or running a vehicle. For example: if your business was a garage, could you help support the costs of maintaining and servicing the centre vehicle? You might like to part or fully sponsor a programme or type of group such as the young leaders training or a school behavioural unit; provide for canoe paddles, safety kits or even a new safety boat. We will always appropriately acknowledge support from businesses.

## **Organise a sponsored event:**

This can be done individually, such as a run or sponsored silence or as a group doing a sponsored carwash or event. We will provide charity numbers and sponsor forms.

## **Fill up the CYE moneybox:**

Then send in a cheque for the contents (keep the box). If you don't have a moneybox, please contact us or pick one up from the centre. Apparently every household has an average of 39p in the sofa so start looking now!

## **Making a gift through your will:**

Now of course we don't want to lose you, but people have wanted to support the work through a legacy. These gifts are lump sums by nature and are unexpected and can often open up new areas of work or help start a new building fund, or provide a specific piece of equipment. We have some helpful booklets at the centre on making a will, so please contact us for more information, and we can also put you in touch with a reliable Solicitor to assist in the process.
